Praise and Worship – Ephesians 4:1-3 - I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another **in love**, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Art/Media 1 Corinthians 16:14 - Let all that you do be done in love.

Michael and Sherrie Lienau – Pray for each of these projects to glorify God, to come out to the intended audiences with full funding and to usher people into the Kingdom who may not otherwise hear the gospel.

Business Galatians 5:13-14 - For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. For the whole law is fulfilled in one word: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

- Farming is very important to Whatcom County. Pray that farmers will have the weather to facilitate the harvest process, the labor they need, and markets for their crops.
- Pray for transparent regulations concerning wetlands and property development in our county. Property can unexpectedly be labeled a wetland, rendering it unusable. This impacts the expansion of businesses and directly impacts the affordability of housing.

Church 1 John 4:7 - Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God.

- Pray for the Vacation Bible Schools that will take place throughout the county this summer. Pray that many kids would come from families that do not go to church. Pray for the kids to encounter Jesus and take Him home!
- Pray for families and churches to disciple the kids who begin a relationship with Jesus at summer camps.
- Pray for the many efforts from para-church groups like Young Life as they seek to reach unchurched kids.

Development Galatians 6:2 - Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.

 Many of our neighbors, kids and families, will be without school services like counseling during the summer months. Father, give us eyes to see those who live near us and need your love.

Education 1 Peter 4:8-Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins.

 Each of us knows several children in this county. In prayer speak the names of theses kids out loud to the father asking Him to protect them physically and spiritually this summer.

Family Romans 13:10 - Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

- Pray for all the county families sending their kids to Christian summer camps (eg. at the Firs). Pray for staff members to be led by the Holy Spirit and that hundreds of kids would make decisions to follow Jesus as Savior.
- Pray for the K-8 Kid's Encounter camp the 3rd week of July. Kids will learn to hear the voice of God speaking to them. Pray for volunteers, leadership and the presence of Holy Spirit during the camp (registration and info at www.lowpc.org).

Government Hebrews 10:24-25 - And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

• Pray against the division the enemy seeks to use during the election year, and for integrity of the election process.

Health 1 Peter 4:10 - As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace

 Pray for our health care professionals, for both physical and mental health, and all who are struggling with the weight of the Fentanyl crisis, from first responders and ER to after-care and counseling.

International Missions/Israel/Native Americans

John 13:34-35 - A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."
