Prayer for Whatcom County and the World – Jan-Feb 2025

Praise and Worship – Psalm 66:16-20

- ¹⁶ Come and listen, all you who fear God,
and I will tell you what he did for me.
- ¹⁷ For I cried out to him for help,
praising him as I spoke.
- ¹⁸ If I had not confessed the sin in my heart,
the Lord would not have listened.
- ¹⁹ But God did listen!
He paid attention to my prayer.
- ²⁰ Praise God, who did not ignore my prayer
or withdraw his unfailing love from me.

Here we are in 2025. WOW! Let us begin the year remembering the God we know, we pray to, with whom we have relationship. Our Savior is a God who listens to the prayers of His children. Praying for Whatcom County & the World

For each area of prayer below your partnership in prayer is exactly what the apostle Paul requested in 2 Cor 1:11 - "You also must help us by prayer, so that many will give thanks on our behalf for the blessing granted us through the prayers of many."

Art/Media James 1:5-6

- News: now in today's media there is less reporting of news and more views/opinions. Pray that people will seek truth and not take things at face value.
- Praise God that we have 1000's of Christian radio stations in USA - like nowhere else in world. Pray the leadership of these stations have a vision to share the gospel boldly.

Business Psalm 31:3

- Pray for the permitting process (government regulations) in Bellingham and Whatcom County to allow for growth. Chick-fil-A has cleared everything to build (and hire many) but one city requirement that is halting the whole project.
- The availability of housing makes it hard to put good workers with good businesses. Pray for open and streamlined regulations for building affordable housing.
- Water rights: Pray for God's wisdom that will protect farms and bring godly stewardship of our water.

Church John 17:22-23

- Pray for unity w/in the body of Christ. Pray for corporate prayer, worship and community service projects in each local area (pray for the area and churches near your church).
- The goal of all our prayers is for God to pour out His Spirit in revival. Pray for the church to be hungry for those things that are proven to attract His Presence and favor.

Development Psalm 133

- Lord is uniting many ministries (Engedi, Love Life, New Way, Whatcom County Pregnancy Center, Lighthouse Mission + others). Pray for the continued working together between the Church and these ministries.

Pray for the development of chaplains for our first responders. Police and Fire Chiefs have asked for help. Ask God to raise up local members of the body of Christ to show the heart and love of Christ to our brothers and sisters who spend their lives helping others.

Education Isaiah 40:28-29, Psalm 31:24

- Stresses are overwhelming so educators need the love of God poured in to overcome the stress. (Education issues: Less money so fewer services and larger classes; kids' behavior is increasingly challenging plus many teachers are required to teach curriculum that is opposed to faith.)
- Ephesians 1:17-18. Wisdom and revelation from the Lord to solve problems that are bigger than can be solved by one teacher or administrator. Pray that teachers will pray and wait on the Lord and then move when they hear from God.

Family Psalm 127:1,3, *"Unless the Lord builds the house the work of the builders is wasted", "Children are a gift from the Lord; they are a reward from Him."*

- Ask the Father to Restore the Family, specifically pro-family laws. WA does not support the nuclear family.
- LOWPC will have a family conference In March to train how to have a family altar of prayer in the home (more info later). Pray that the Father will restore the Family altar of prayer in every believer's home.

Government Luke 18:1, 11:13

- Support government Leaders in prayer. (eg. Mark Stremmer on county council). Pray for an encounter with Jesus - Pray, specifically for ones we disagree with, as Jesus would pray - from God's heart of love.
- Feb 20, LOWPC will be part of a prayer walk on the capital campus in Olympia. Pray for many churches to come pray for our government. (info below if you'd like to join)

Health Isaiah 41:8-10

- Corporate policies and state laws are requiring providers to have explicit conversations about gender choices with 13-year-olds even without parents' consent or presence. Pray for the protection of our children from ideological
